They are a welcoming community of staff and volunteers serving all Veterans and their families. As a single point of contact for Veterans, military members and their families, they engage, support and make it easy for Veterans and their families to connect with what they need with a commitment to providing a welcoming place to call home. Their in-house programs and services are diverse and rely on partnerships and collaboration. Clear Path's focus is on restoring, reconnecting and integrating. Their programs and services are innovative, adaptive and flexible to the needs of those who serve.

2019-2021

In 2019, 500 employees contributed a total of \$11,359.60. With MAPFRE USA's match of \$11,359.60, a total of \$22,719.20 was donated to the Adam Bullen Memorial Foundation. This foundation was started in Adam's memory by his family as a charitable organization that provides emotional and financial support to children and adults with cancer.

In 2020, 800 employees contributed a total of \$16,423.49. With MAPFRE USA's match of \$16,423,49, a total of \$32,846,98 was donated. Two organizations were selected in 2020, each receiving \$16,423,49. The SHINE Initiative develops funding and strategic alliances to improve public awareness and understanding of mental health issues, research and treatment. The Sojourner Center provides services to victims of domestic violence, working with professionals in the field of education, research and advocacy with a goal of ending domestic violence.

In 2021, 500 employes contributed a total of \$41,465.20. With MAPFRE USA's match of \$41,465.20, a total of \$82,930.40 was donated to Feeding America. The Feeding America network is the nation's largest domestic hunger-relief organization, working to connect people with food and end hunger – providing over 4.3 billion meals annually and helping one in seven Americans facing hunger live more secure and stable lives.
